

Bake Sales which meet all of the following criteria are exempt from Platte County food establishment requirements:

- The food item being produced is a non-potentially hazardous baked food item. This does not include cream puffs, cream based pies and cakes, cheese-cakes and any other items that would be considered potentially hazardous.
- If baked items are prepared in a private home the sale or giveaway of these items should be accompanied with a placard informing the consumer that the food is prepared in a kitchen that is not subject to regulation and inspection by the Department.
- Bake sale must be conducted by a non-profit organization or at a Farmer's Market

* If selling or giving away potentially hazardous foods, for example a chili supper, turkey dinner, spaghetti supper or hot dogs you must obtain a Temporary Food Establishment Permit or food items must be made in an inspected kitchen.
